NOTES TO THE FEE STRUCTURE 2010-2011

1. **Registration Fee** is payable at the time of submission of the completed Application Form for the Application to be recognized and processed. It is a one-time, non-refundable payment.
2. The **Admission Fee** is a one-time, non-refundable payment.
3. The **Caution Deposit** is interest-free and is refunded when the child is withdrawn from the school in compliance with the rules of the school. Dues/Outstandings as determined by the school, if any, will be adjusted against this refund. Please read, understand and abide by the **Withdrawal and Refund Rules** of the school, available separately, applicable to all students.
4. The **Annual School Fee** includes the cost of tuition, living, extra-curricular activities, all curriculum related books & notebooks, sports, non-personal sports gear, basic medical care and recreational activities. However, the Examination Fees payable to the Board/University will be payable by the parent additionally.
5. **Girl Students** are eligible to a 25% concession in the **Annual School Fee** for 3 Academic Years (2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013) subject to display of consistently satisfactory Academic and Behavioural performance and consistent parental compliance of school rules and regulations. This concession will be applicable to full fee paying students only. Students benefitting from other forms of assistance or scholarships will not be eligible. All other heads of charges will be applicable in full.
6. The **One-Time payment option** is not available to students appearing for the Board Examinations.
7. **NRI Parents** are required to comply with the laws of Foreign Exchange prevailing in India while making the payments.
8. The cost of **Uniforms, Accessories and all other necessities** as procured by the school on behalf of the child will be debited to the student's **Imprest Account**.
9. The cost of **Personal consumables** ordered/procured by the school for the student like toiletries, tuck, etc will be debited to the student's **Imprest Account**.
10. All bed & linen items will be provided by the school at no extra charge.
11. The cost of **Travel** that the school incurs on behalf of the child while travelling out of school under any mode of travel shall be debited to the student account.
12. The cost of excursions/tours will be charged to the student by distributing the overall expenditure incurred across all participating students.
13. **Payments** must be made by cheques or demand drafts in favour of "Parkwood School International" payable at Hyderabad only. For Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) to the school's bank account, please contact the City Office for our bank details.
14. The remittance of the school fee within the due date is the **responsibility** of the Parent/Guardian as per the due dates mentioned above. Delayed payments will attract penal charges at Rs. 150 per calendar day till the reopening of the school and Rs. 200 per day thereafter for the next 30 days. Thereafter, the child will be debarred from attending school and also result in "striking-off" the name of the student from the rolls of the school.
15. Parents are requested to be aware of the **Withdrawal and Refund Rules of the School**. With any payment made corresponding to the details provided in this document, it automatically confirms that the parent has read, understood and agreed to abide by the refund policy fully.
16. Barring the unforeseen, parents are advised to expect an increase of about 10% in the Annual Fees for the Academic Year 2011-2012.
17. The above Fee structure does not include Government Taxes and Levies. If they are introduced at any time, parents will be liable to pay the same as applicable.
